Paris with Page Knox: Sargent's Paris Years

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 24 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2025 (4 NIGHTS)

Following the success of her previous art- and history-focused journeys, art historian Page Knox will lead an exclusive trip to Paris in Fall 2025. Knox, along with horticulturalist and expert guide Amy Kupec Larue, will immerse guests in the fascinating life and work of John Singer Sargent during his time in the city. Travelers will explore the key locations that shaped Sargent's art, including his former addresses in the 6th and 17th arrondissements, and iconic spots like the Luxembourg Gardens, where many of his masterpieces were created. Guests will gain access to a private, after-hours tour of the Musée d'Orsay's special exhibition "Sargent, The Paris Years," followed by a celebratory gala dinner; celebrate 150 years of the Palais Garnier with a behind-the-scenes tour; explore Belle Époque Paris; and dive into the world of American artists in Paris during the late 19th century.

She works contractually at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, giving public gallery talks and lectures in special exhibitions as well as the permanent collection, teaching classes at the museum. Page graduated from Yale University with a double major in Art History and Economics, and she spent her twenties in the financial world. Before returning to school, she worked at the Yale Center for British Art.



Horticultural expert, botanist and art historian **Amy Kupec Larue** has been living, working and traveling in Europe for 30 years, in pursuit of her passion for flowers, plants and French culture. Since 2005, she has been guiding garden aficionados and groups on tours through public and private gardens in Paris, Normandy, the Loire Valley, the South of France and Tuscany. Amy has guided travelers on Insider Journeys to the Loire Valley, Bordeaux, Paris, Napa Valley and Portugal.

With a fabulous location overlooking the Tuileries gardens on Rue de Rivoli, Le Meurice is an exquisite Palace hotel that manages to deliver old-world Parisian elegance with a modern flourish. While the 160 rooms and suites still feel grand, new fabrics and color schemes are muted and elegant—picture floral patterns on shiny silk in combinations like orange, purple, magenta and grey. Itinerary

DAY 1, OCT. 24: WELCOME TO PARIS

- Arrive in Paris and transfer to the hotel
- Welcome cocktails at a private residence with your fellow travelers, followed by dinner

OVERNIGHT: LE MEURICE | MEALS: D

DAY 2, OCT. 25: SARGENT'S LIFE & WORK

- Spend the day learning about Sargent's Parisian life and work on an interactive tour with your hosts Page Knox and Amy Kupec Larue. Page and Amy will guide you through the different arrondissements of Paris—including the 6th and 17th, Sargent's former home addresses, and the Luxembourg Gardens. During the tour, you will stop for lunch and walk into venues of historical importance.
- Afternoon at leisure to rest and refresh before evening festivities.
- This evening, in partnership with the American Friends of the Orsay and Orangerie Museums, gain exclusive entrée to the Musée d'Orsay's celebratory gala evening. Enjoy cocktails and an after-hours private tour of the "Sargent, The Paris Years (1874-1884)" and "Paul Troubetzkoy, The Sculptor Prince" exhibitions, followed by dinner in the elegant restaurant with a menu by Alain Ducasse and his team. Funds from the dinner will be a donation to the museum.

Itinerary

DAY 3, OCT. 26: PARIS BELLE ÉPOQUE

- Begin the morning with a walking tour of Le Marais and a visit to the Carnavalet Museum, which focuses on the history of Paris. Learn about Sargent's life during the Belle Époque era, before heading to lunch at a local restaurant.
- Celebrate 150 years of the Palais Garnier opera house with a backstage tour. Behind the glittering façade lies a captivating history—discover the breathtaking public spaces, but also the hidden places like the cabestans room under the stage holding elaborate 19th-century machinery that was once used to manage special effects. View the underground “lake” that inspired *The Phantom of the Opera* and learn why Marc Chagall's painted ceiling was originally controversial when unveiled.
- Spend the evening and dinner at leisure.

OVERNIGHT: LE MEURICE | MEALS: B, L

DAY 4, OCT. 27: AMERICANS IN PARIS

- This morning, join Page and Amy for an “Americans in Paris” tour to discover the American artists who followed the Impressionist movement, as well as the difference between French and American Impressionism.
- Lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a visit to a special collection dedicated to American Art.
- Festive farewell dinner at a special location with your fellow travelers and hosts

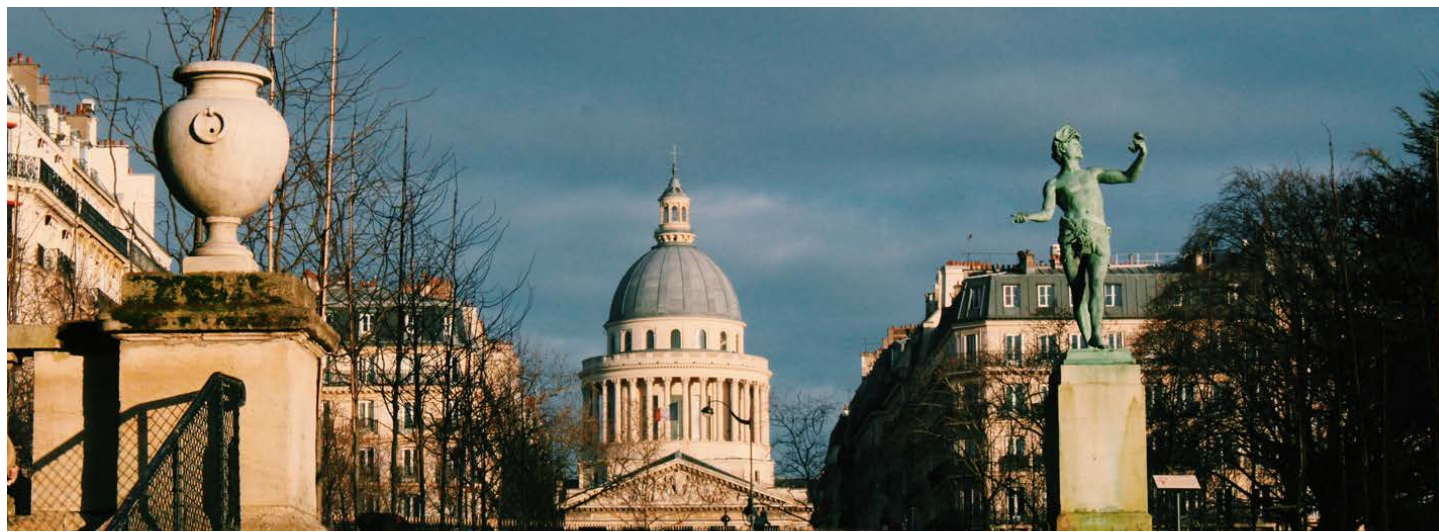

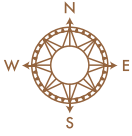

Know Before You Go: Global Rescue & Trip Insurance



Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, ***all guests on International Indagare Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit.*** Global Rescue is not travel or trip insurance, but in the event that an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance. Indagare also strongly recommend that you purchase additional travel insurance for your trip, in case an unforeseen emergency arises or you need medical treatment while traveling. Global Rescue Overview

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200-plus medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000-plus operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

For the duration of any Indagare Journey you have access to:

- **24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest**
- **Evacuations from the point of injury / illness to home country hospital (pending the type of care and level of care needed)**
- **Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries**

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation

It is important to note that the **Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of an Indagare Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance**, which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also strongly recommends that guests joining Indagare Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s).** Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.**

Note: Plans from some providers can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure; others require 14 days notice. Indagare recommends opting in to a plan well in advance of your trip. Please be advised that Indagare is not a licensed insurance company or advisor.
