

Go behind closed doors in Vienna's sprawling palaces to survey private family art and design collections, with works by revered European artists and pieces that once belonged to the imperial family—all of which provide insight into the rich history of the Habsburg Monarchy.

Spend an evening gaining an inside look at the Belvedere Palace after it has closed to the public. This architectural masterpiece of bygone aristocratic splendor houses Gustav Klimt's *The Kiss*, among many works by the artist and his contemporaries Egon Schiele and Helene Funke.

Enjoy an exclusive visit to the Liechtenstein Garden Palace—which holds the family's most prestigious art—as well as a visit to the sprawling Schönbrunn Palace and its Baroque gardens.

Stay at one of the city's most iconic luxury hotels (and one of the oldest family-owned hotels in Europe)—the Hotel Sacher.

ACCOMMODATION



HOTEL SACHER

The family-owned Sacher is Vienna's most iconic property. The chandelier-lit reception halls and antique-filled drawing rooms exude old-world elegance, and while the 152-room property occupies a city block, its clever layout and cozy public spaces maintain an intimate feel. The rooms, designed by owner Elisabeth Gürtler and star French designer Pierre-Yves Rochon, include high-quality reproduction antiques, silk-covered walls, white stucco along the ceilings and original paintings from the Sacher's private collection. The Sacher spa has a short but terrific menu of treatments featuring Ligne St. Barth's and La Prairie products. On the ground floor, guests can dine at Café Sacher, renowned for its Sachertorte.

Itinerary



DAY 1, SEPT. 15: WELCOME TO VIENNA

- Arrive at the Vienna Airport and transfer to the Hotel Sacher for check-in.
- Later in the afternoon, embark on a guided walking tour of the medieval alleyways and coffee houses of the Old Town, stopping at St. Stephen's Cathedral for a view of the city.
- Cocktails and special welcome dinner with Matthias and Alexandra Winkler, the owners of Hotel Sacher.

OVERNIGHT: HOTEL SACHER | MEALS: D

DAY 2, SEPT. 16: SCHÖNBRUNN & BELVEDERE PALACES

- Discover the sprawling Schönbrunn Palace—once the summer residence of the imperial Habsburg family—with more than 1,400 Rococo rooms, and visit the Bergl Rooms.
- Lunch at a local restaurant before an afternoon visit of the Vienna State Opera. (The tour does not include an opera performance. Indagare can arrange opera performance tickets during the trip for those interested, at an additional cost).
- Rest and refresh for an after-hours evening of cocktails and canapés at the Belvedere Palace, where you will have Gustav Klimt's *The Kiss* all to yourselves.
- Dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

DAY 3, SEPT. 17: SPANISH RIDING SCHOOL & ATELIERS

- Behind-the-scenes tour of the famous Spanish Riding School, an Austrian institution where the Lipizzaner horses demonstrate their skills and training.
- Lunch in town before exploring Vienna's finest family-owned ateliers dating back to the Hofburg period
- Dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.

DAY 4, SEPT. 18: LIECHTENSTEIN PALACE & ALBERTINA

- Morning at leisure
- Exclusive visit to the Liechtenstein Garden Palace, where the family's prestigious art holdings are kept (including works by Rubens, Raphael and Rembrandt)
- Lunch at the Garden Palace's Vinothek
- Curator-guided tour of the Albertina Museum, home to the world's largest graphic arts collections with works by Dürer and Michelangelo
- Drinks at the Heidi Horton Collection with the collection's art advisor. Opened in June 2022, the collection amassed over decades by Heidi Goëss-Horten has been declared one of the best in Europe, showcasing hundreds of 20th-century masterpieces.
- Dinner at leisure. Indagare is happy to provide restaurant recommendations.


DAY 5, SEPT. 19: LEOPOLD & KUNSTHISTORISCHES MUSEUMS

- Start your morning at the Leopold Museum, which houses the world's largest and most important Egon Schiele collection.
- Lunch in the MuseumsQuartier complex
- Make your way to the Kunsthistorisches (Art History) Museum to see its vast array of eminent works, including the world's largest collection of works by Bruegel the Elder.
- Return to the hotel for time to rest and refresh
- Festive farewell dinner

Know Before You Go: Global Rescue & Trip Insurance

Complimentary International Global Rescue Services Coverage

To help you travel more safely, responsibly and seamlessly, as part of your signup and registration, all guests on International Indagare Journeys receive Global Rescue coverage for the dates of their journey as an added benefit. This means that in the event an emergency occurs during the trip, guests have access to a variety of services, including medical assistance and evacuation assistance.

Global Rescue Overview

Global Rescue was founded in 2004 and has five operations centers and offices in five countries, with 200+ medical centers of excellence worldwide and 20,000-plus operations globally. Global Rescue operations centers are staffed by experienced nurses, paramedics and military special operations veterans.

For the duration of any Indagare Journey you have access to:

- 24/7 medical assistance and advisory services for natural disasters, terror attacks and civil unrest
- Evacuations from the point of injury/illness to home country hospital (at no additional cost)
- Travel intelligence services, including alerts and real-time destination reports for 215 countries

Additional services include: symptom triage, referral to local hospital or clinic, urgent/emergency message relay, telephonic support, health information services, replacement of lost medical supplies & medical triage.

Additional Trip Insurance Recommendation

It is important to note that the Global Rescue coverage that comes with every purchase of an Indagare Journey is not the same as travel or trip insurance, which—among other features—offers financial protection concerning situations that occur before a trip begins and require a change or cancellation of travel plans. These can include a personal or family illnesses or other unexpected factors such as lost luggage, flight disruption, illnesses or accidents that require emergency medical treatment and/or hospitalization.

So that guests can plan and undertake travel with the minimum possible financial risks, **Indagare also strongly recommends that guests joining Indagare Journeys trips purchase travel insurance to cover their trip(s).** Travel insurance may be obtained from any of a number of providers that specialize in such insurance, and as a courtesy to guests, **Indagare can arrange for a quote for coverage with our preferred providers to be prepared and emailed directly to you at your request.**

Note: Plans from some providers can be purchased up to 24 hours prior to departure; others require 14 days notice. Indagare recommends opting in to a plan well in advance of your trip. Please be advised that Indagare is not a licensed insurance company or advisor.
